GOVERNMENT AND INDUSTRY RECOMMENDATIONS

Transport Canada and the Rubber Association of Canada advise motorists to think about safe driving in winter.



Vehicle handling will be improved when tires of the same type, size, speed rating and load index are installed on all four wheels. Tires marked with the pictograph of a peaked

mountain with a snowflake meet specific snow traction performance requirements, and have been designed specifically for use in severe snow conditions

If you intend driving in severe winter conditions, install four winter tires that meet the “snow tire” designation on your vehicle. These snow tires will assist you to control your vehicle safely in slippery conditions.

Wide, high performance tires, other than those that are specifically designed as snow tires, are not suitable for use on snow covered roads.

FOUNTAIN TIRE'S WINTER TIRE POLICY

Transport Canada and The Rubber Association of Canada recommend you install winter tires in all wheel positions. Based on this recommendation, Fountain Tire has had the following winter tire policy, **effective January 1, 2003:**

Fountain Tire will sell and install all tires rated with a 3-Peak Mountain Snowflake in sets of four (4) only. This policy applies to all front-wheel, all-wheel, four-wheel and rear-wheel drive cars, minivans, SUVs or pickup trucks for the following circumstances:

WINTER TIRE PURCHASES

When you purchase any tires rated with a 3-Peak Mountain Snowflake at Fountain Tire, only four (4) of these tires will be sold and installed.

TIRE CHANGEOVERS

If you would like to change over your current tires to your tires rated with a 3-Peak Mountain Snowflake, Fountain Tire will only install these tires if they are in a set of four (4).
